## **WSMR RECREATIONAL SMALL ARMS RANGE RULES FACILITY BLDG 19008**

- The Recreational Small Arms Range is open to use by active and retired military and family members, DoD identification card holders and their family members, and on post contractors (with contractor ID and CAC Card). Authorized patrons may bring guests (the host is responsible for the actions of their guest(s)). Minor children over the age of 12 must remain under the closest supervision of their parents/guardians at all times. Children under 12 are not allowed on the Recreational Small Arms Range.
- All persons must sign in at the Outdoor Recreation Facility Bldg 1338 and pick up the flag and key.
- Everyone is requested to adhere to all Rules and Regulations set forth in this packet.
- You must bring your own targets. Metal and glass targets are prohibited. The range must be cleaned prior to leaving.
- Please exercise caution not to accidentally discharge firearm. The use of clearing barrels is mandatory.
- Alcohol, in any form is prohibited on any ranges. Outdoor Recreation personnel will refuse admittance to any range if an individual appears to be under the influence of alcohol.
- Authorized Ammunition for Range 1 is 5.56mm and 7.62mm
- Authorized Ammunition for Range 5 is 9mm, 10/12 Gauge, .22, .38, .40, .45.
- Prohibited Firearms/Ammunition are any rounds exceeding 7.62mm in size (of any kind) and steel jacketed ammunition of any kind.
- Clay pigeon throwers are prohibited at the range.
- Fully automatic firearms are strictly prohibited.
- All firing will be done from the static position.
- You will not fire down range while any person is past the firing line.
- You will remove all pistol and rifle magazines and clear all firearms before leaving the Range.
- All observing/non firing individuals will be located at a safe distance behind the firing line. Individuals will only occupy Ranges, all other wildlife areas are STRICTLY OFF LIMITS.
- If you see an unsafe act at any time you will yell CEASE FIRE and assess the situation.
- OUTDOOR RECREATION/DPTMS/DES personnel can remove any person at any time due to non adherence to any of the rules and regulations mentioned in this packet.

- If weather conditions become unfavorable Outdoor Recreation Personnel may stop recreational firing at any time, the user will use prudent judgment on all weather related matters and evacuate the range accordingly.
- If aircraft appears within 1 mile of the Small Arms Range all firing will cease immediately until clear.
- NO HUNTING is allowed on the Small Arms Range. If wildlife wanders into your line of sight wait until clear.
- Park only in authorized parking areas. 4 x 4 exploring is prohibited on the Small Arms Range. Stay on designated roads.
- ALL brass and targets will be picked up before departing the range.
- OUTDOOR RECREATION will inspect the range either before patrons leave the range or on the First Duty day after the range was utilized, damages caused will be solely the responsibility of the user.
- Night fire is prohibited. Firing will be done in daylight only.
- Ear & Eye Protection will be worn by all persons at all times while on the Range.
- ALL ACCIDENTS/INJURIES, DAMAGE, NO MATTER HOW MINIMAL WILL BE REPORTED TO THE OUTDOOR RECREATION. NO EXCEPTIONS, report to OUTDOOR RECREATION 575-678-1713 or to the DPTMS watch officer 575-678-8999.
